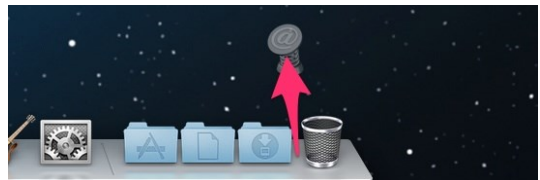


# Replacing the Network Share Dock Icon(s) on a College Mac

The location of your network file shares has changed as of July 14, 2014. If your dock still has an icon to connect to the old I: or J: drive, this document will show you how to remove the existing icon and replace it with one for the new location (`\\storage.brynmawr.edu`). *Note: This action must be performed from on campus or while connected via the Network Connect utility of the VPN (ingress.brynmawr.edu). For help using the VPN, see <http://techbar.blogs.brynmawr.edu/1019> and use Method 2 in the attached document.*

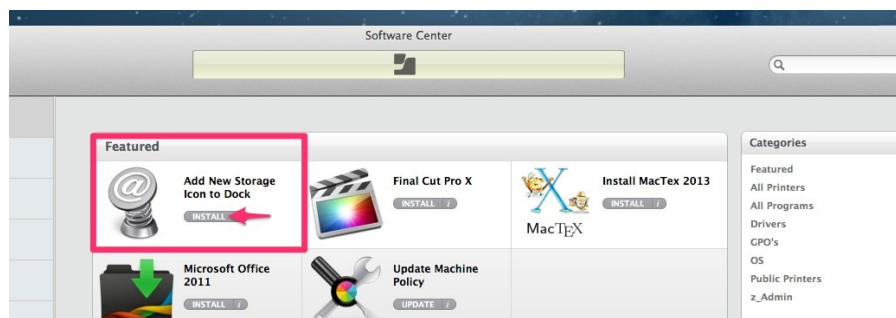
1. Remove the old icon from the Dock, by dragging it an inch or more off the Dock and holding it for a few seconds, then release; the icon will disappear in a poof of smoke. If you have two Dock icons for file shares, remove both of them.



2. Next, open Software Center from the Applications folder. The Software Center icon, shown below, may already be on your Dock. You can also find the application by searching for it in Spotlight, in the upper right of your screen.



3. Once the application loads, the featured page will have an item entitled "Add New Storage Icon to Dock." Click install. You will be greeted with a description of what you are about to run. Then, click install again.



4. During the installation, you will see your Dock disappear and then reappear. After this happens, your Dock will have the new Storage icon added to the left of the applications folder. You can now quit the Software Center application.
